

DESIGN FOR A LACE TABLECLOTH

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that Howard Hooven, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Turk Road and Wells Road, Doylestown, in the county of Bucks and State of Pennsylvania, has invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lace Tablecloth, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, in which the figure is a face view of a quarter section of the lace tablecloth showing my new design, the other three sections being identical with that here disclosed, arranged in proper relation to complete the lace tablecloth. The quarter section is shown over a dark background to bring out the details of the lace design.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a lace tablecloth, substantially as shown and described.
