

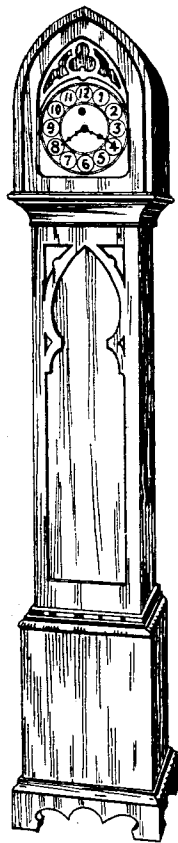

DESIGN FOR A CLOCK CASE

Application filed July 16, 1929. Serial No. 32,064. Term of patent  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.

*To all whom it may concern:*
