

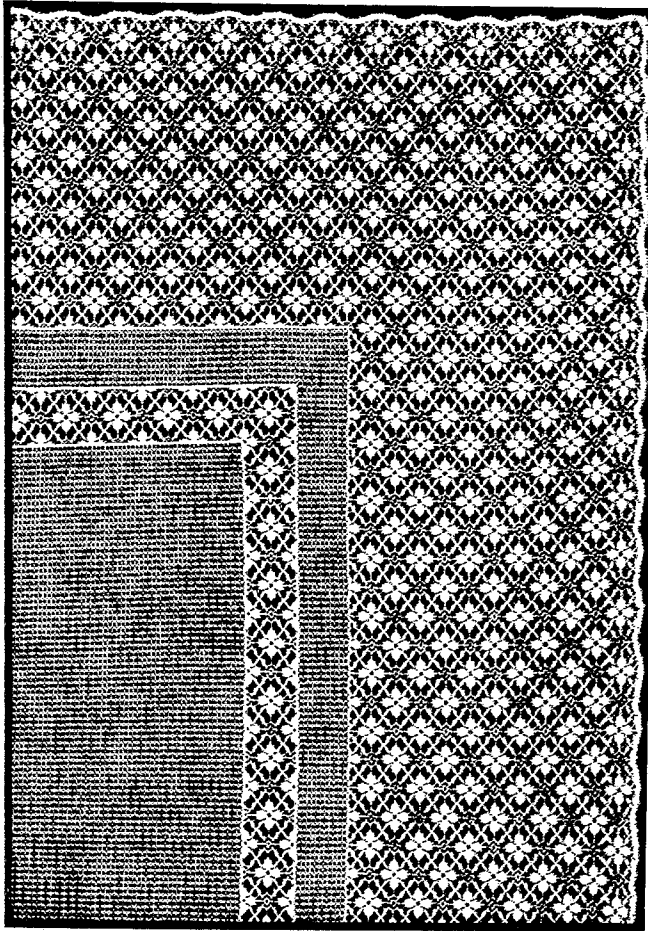

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that James Waterfield, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 5333 Wakefield Street, Philadelphia, in the county of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, has invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Lace Tablecloth, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof in which the figure is a face view of a quarter section of the lace tablecloth showing my new de-

sign, the other three sections being identical with that here disclosed, arranged in proper relation to complete the lace tablecloth. The quarter section is shown over a dark background to bring out the details of the lace design.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a lace tablecloth substantially as shown and described.
