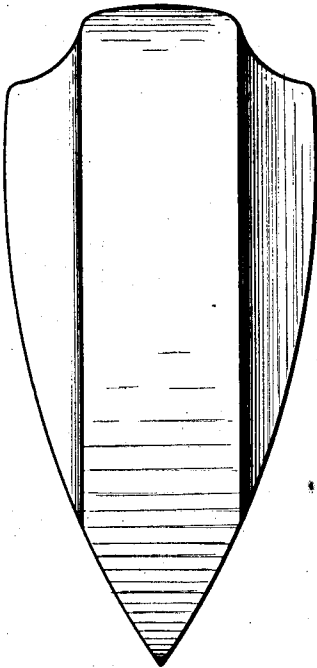
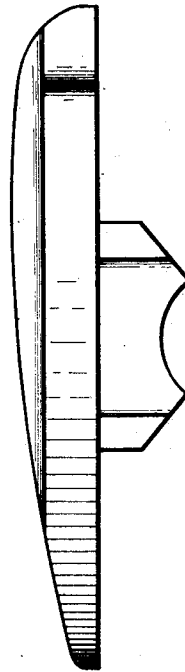

DESIGN FOR A CLAMP PLATE FOR VEHICLE BUMPERS.

Application filed June 17, 1927. Serial No. 22,479. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, HERBERT S. JANDUS and JOHN RICHARD MORGAN, citizens of the United States, residing at Detroit, in the county of Wayne and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Clamp Plate for Vehicle Bumpers, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part hereof, wherein—

Fig. 1 represents a front elevation and Fig. 2 a side elevation of a clamp plate for vehicle bumpers exhibiting our new design. An important feature of our design is the paneled effect produced by the arrangement of grooves shown in the drawing.

We claim:

The ornamental design for a clamp plate for vehicle bumpers, as shown and described.
