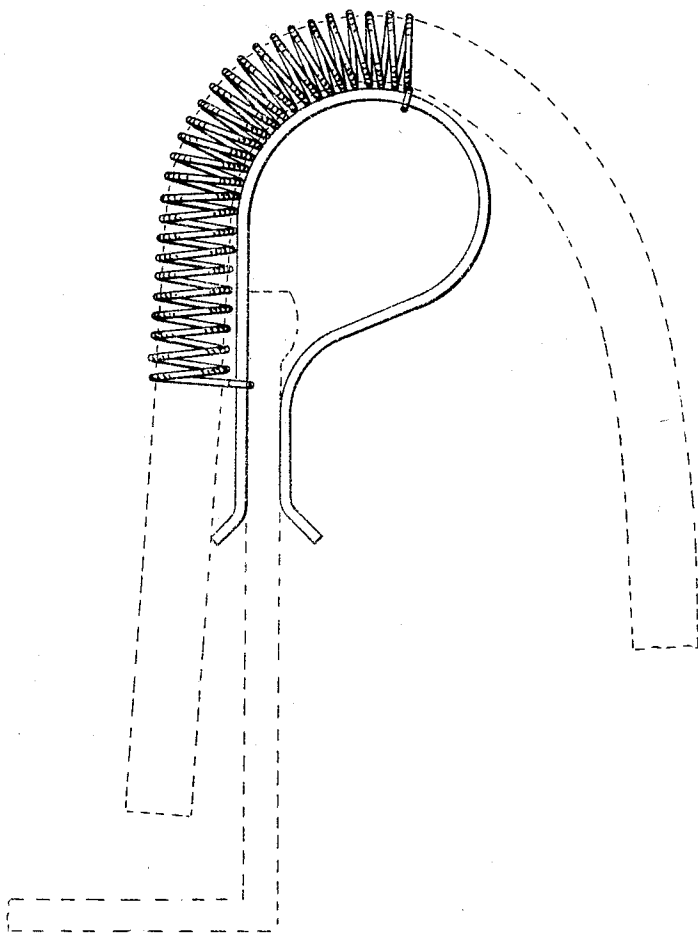
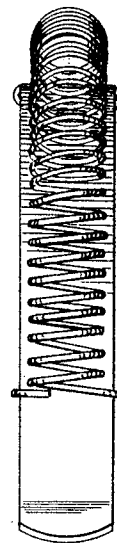

DESIGN FOR A SIPHON-TUBE HOLDER.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, FRED G. MEYER, a citizen of the United States, residing at Detroit, in the county of Wayne and State of Michigan, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Siphon-Tube Holder, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

In the accompanying drawing,

Figure 1 is a side elevation of my design for a siphon tube holder in which the wall of a receptacle supporting the holder and the siphon tube are indicated in dashed lines.

Fig. 2 is a view in front elevation of the design shown in Fig. 1.
