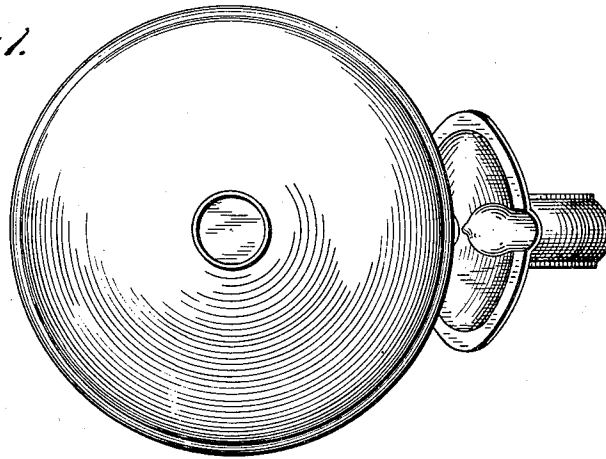
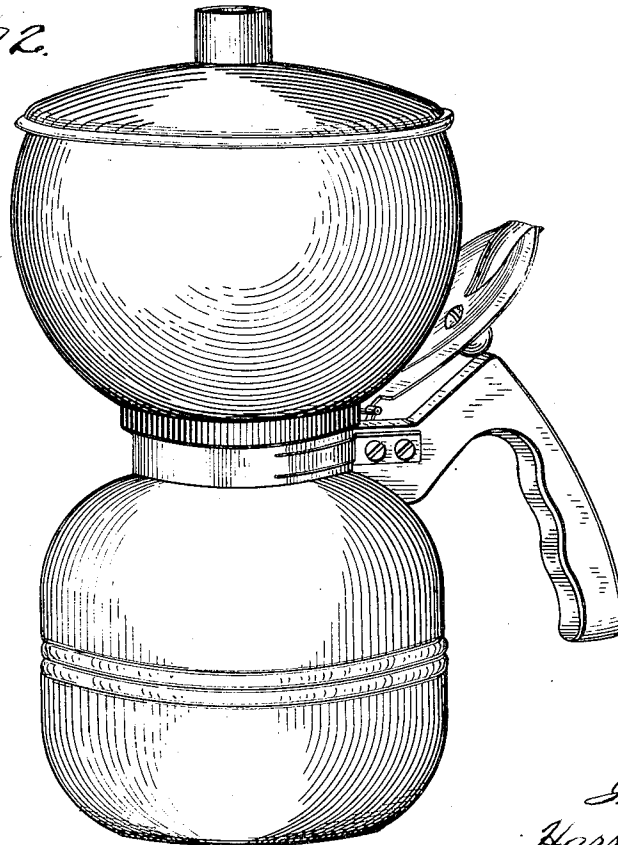

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Harry Wohl, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Vacuum Coffee Maker, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part hereof.

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a vacuum coffee maker, showing my new design; and
