

(54) Title: SPRING CLIP FOR USE IN A CONVERTIBLE TOP HAVING SIDE TENSION CABLES



(57) Abstract: A one piece rod spring clip is attached to a tensioning cable in a convertible top. The rod spring clip (40) includes a leg that is aligned with an end of the cable. The rod spring clip is secured to the one bow (38) of the convertible top and applies a biasing force to the end of the cable through the action of a flexure portion of the rod spring clip that applies an axial force to the cable
