


FIG. 1 is a view of one side of a combination knife and money clip embodying my new design with the blades being shown in dotted lines in the extended position;

FIG. 2 is a view of the opposite side thereof with the blades being shown in dotted lines in the incased position;

FIGURE 3 is an edge view as seen from the left of FIGURE 1;

FIG. 4 is a view of the other edge thereof;

FIGURE 5 is a top view thereof; and

FIGURE 6 is a bottom view thereof.

The dominant features of my design reside in the portions shown in full lines.

I claim:
