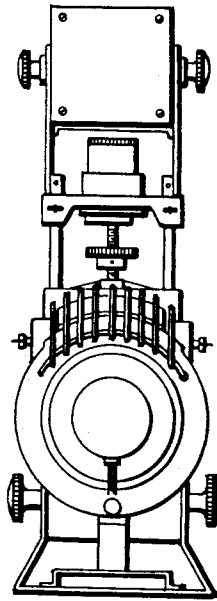
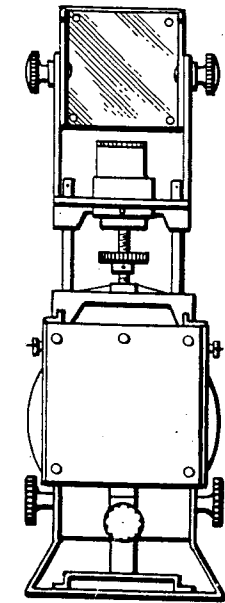
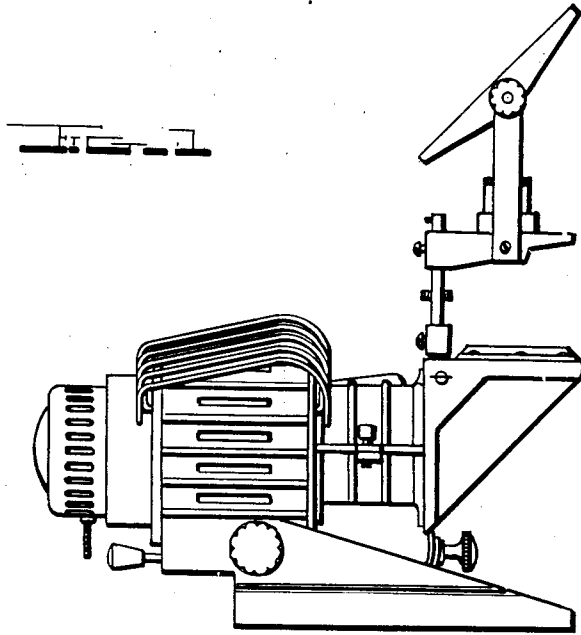

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George E. Hamilton, a citizen of the United States, residing at Meadville, in the county of Crawford and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Picture Projector, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, in which:

Figure 1 is a view in side elevation of a picture projector, showing my new design; and the op-

posite side presents substantially the same appearance as the side shown.

Figure 2 is a view in elevation of the front thereof; and

Figure 3 is a view in elevation of the rear end thereof.
